## Love One Another

(Galatians 5:1-15)

The apostle Paul shared a message with the *Gentile* (non-Jewish) Christians. Obeying only one law will not make you right with God. You would have to obey every law perfectly. But that is impossible. Jesus Christ has set you free. So, live your life as a person who is free.

Having faith and trust in Jesus is what matters to God. Do not allow anyone to make you forget that Jesus has called you to live free. But you are not free to sin. You are free to serve others in love. The whole Law can be summed up this way: "Love your neighbor as you love yourself."
