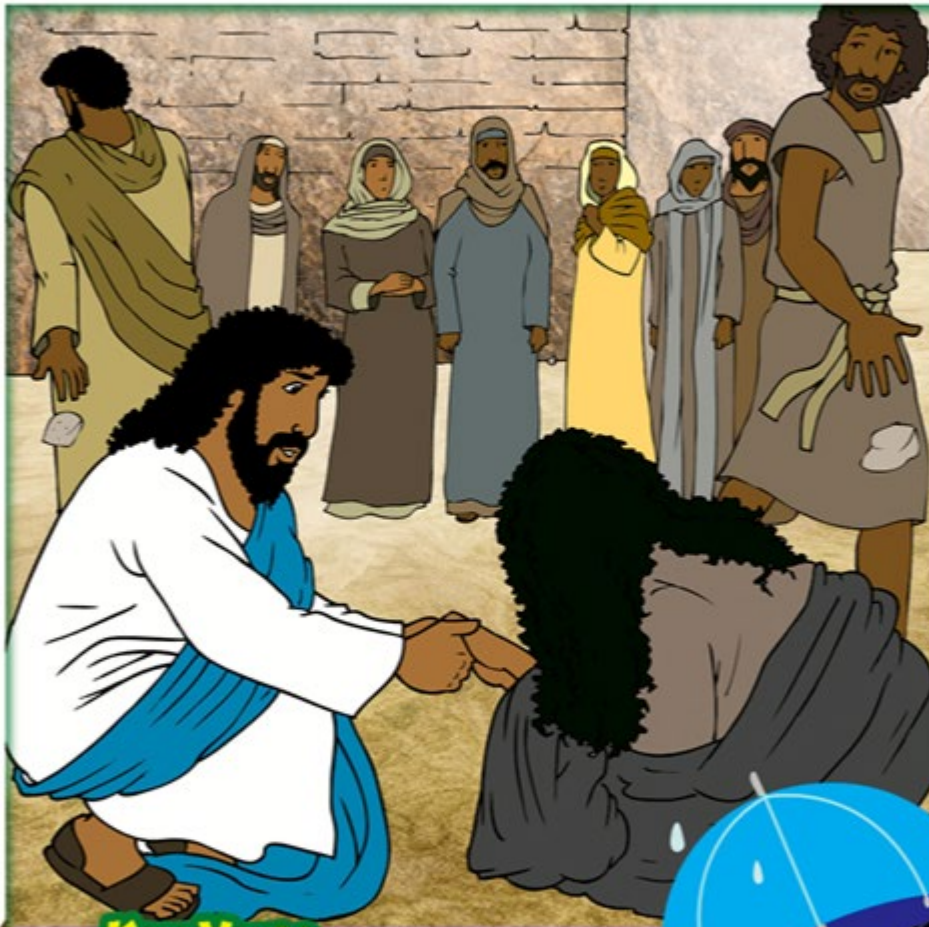

# Forgiving a Sinful Woman

Lesson Scripture: John 8:5-11



## Key Verse

"Neither do I condemn you," Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin." (John 8:11b)





## Forgiving a Sinful Woman

(John 8:5-11)

The Jewish leaders brought to Jesus a woman who had *sinned* (did something that did not please God). They told Jesus that they should throw stones at her to follow Moses' Law. But they wanted to know what Jesus thought they should do. Jesus knelt to write on the ground.

Then Jesus stood and said, "Let anyone who has done nothing wrong throw the first stone." Jesus knelt to write on the ground again. Everyone left.

Jesus asked the woman, "Where are they? Has no one *condemned* (punished) you?" Jesus then forgave the woman and told her to do what was right.

In today's lesson, your child heard that Jewish leaders brought to Jesus a woman who had sinned. The leaders wanted to stone her according to Moses' Law.
